## POLICY STATEMENT

### RELEASE OF CAMPERS

Section A It shall be the policy of Camp Manatoc/Butler to release a Scout only to an authorized person as listed on the Camper Release Form as approved by the Scout's parent or legal guardian.

Section B Each Scout leaving camp shall notify his Unit Leader or Chaperone and the Camp Director as to the estimated time of departure. (The Scout shall wait at the Conference Center for the appropriate adult providing transportation to arrive.)

Section C When the adult arrives, the Camp Director will verify the name on the Camper release Form and ask to see a photo identification card (Driver's License, State Identification Card, Military Identification Card, etc.) After the verification of the name on the form to the picture ID, the adult shall sign out the Scout. The sign-out form shall include the Scout's name, time leaving, time returning and the name and signature of the person the Scout is being released to.

Section D NO SCOUT SHALL BE RELEASED TO ANYONE NOT LISTED ON THE CAMPER RELEASE FORM. HOWEVER, THE UNIT'S LEADER OR CHAPERONE MAY RELEASE THE SCOUT TO THE ADULT BY SIGNING THE WAIVER BELOW. The unit Leader or Chaperone then assumes full responsibility for the safety of the Scout.
